Here's just a few more of our recent victories thanks to our PAF:

2023: Ending Mandatory Fees for SUNY Grad Workers Funding in the NYS Budget to put an end to the crushing fees that SUNY graduate workers - members of CWA Local 1104 - have been forced to pay.



2023: Continued Funding for the CUNY School of Labor Studies

Funding to support one of the only public university programs focused on labor so they can continue to grow enrollment and educate the next generation of workers



2021: The NY HERO Act

Strengthening worker protections by creating new health and safety standards during airborne infectious disease outbreaks, giving workers a stronger voice on the job, and holding employers accountable for dangerous workplaces.

2021: Raising revenue to protect public sector jobs

Raised \$4.3 Billion in new, progressive, annual revenue by ending tax breaks for the rich and to fund our public services.
